Marcia's Frozen in Time

FOREHEAD
Marcia seems to have some heavy-handed Botox (\$2,000 a year), says Miami's Dr. Roger Khouri. "Her forehead is paralyzed. Not only are there no wrinkles, it doesn't move."

CHEEKS
"She appears to have filler or fat injections to her cheeks, submalar area [under the cheekbone] and tear troughs," shares Nashville's Dr. Nicholas Sieveking. Cost: \$3K and up.

NOSE
"Her most recent photos show a more symmetrical nasal tip, and the flatness on the right side is gone," Dr. Sieveking says. "I think she had a revision rhinoplasty [upwards of \$12K]."

SKIN
Marcia's improved skin texture is likely due to "laser resurfacing, perhaps with the carbon dioxide laser [\$1,200 and up]," notes Dr. Sieveking. "Broadband light therapy can also even out tone."

For eight years on *Desperate Housewives*, Marcia Cross played perfectionist Bree Van de Kamp, a buttoned-up homemaker who'd die if one hair were ever out of place. But that was only fiction, right? Maybe not. Judging by the Emmy-nominated ac-

tress' appearance off camera since the show ended in 2012, it seems a bit of her Wisteria Lane personality lingers on. Not only is Marcia as flawlessly svelte as ever, but her face, at age 53, appears immaculately frozen in time. The expert opinion: She looks beautiful —

but a bit too done. "Botox (or possibly a brow-lift) has given her a startled look in her upper face," notes Miami plastic surgeon Dr. Roger Khouri, who does not treat the former *Melrose Place* star. "It's caused by her eyebrows being constantly raised and her too-tight fore-

head." But the mom of twins appears to have had a more natural result from "fillers in her cheeks and apparent rhinoplasty," observes Nashville, Tenn., plastic surgeon Dr. Nicholas Sieveking, who also doesn't call Marcia a patient. "She has nice fullness to her cheeks

that's not excessive. Meanwhile, her nose now has good symmetry and balance with the rest of her features — and does not look operated on." As for her wrinkle-free China doll complexion? "She's maintained her skin well," adds Dr. Sieveking. Bree would be proud! **L&S**
